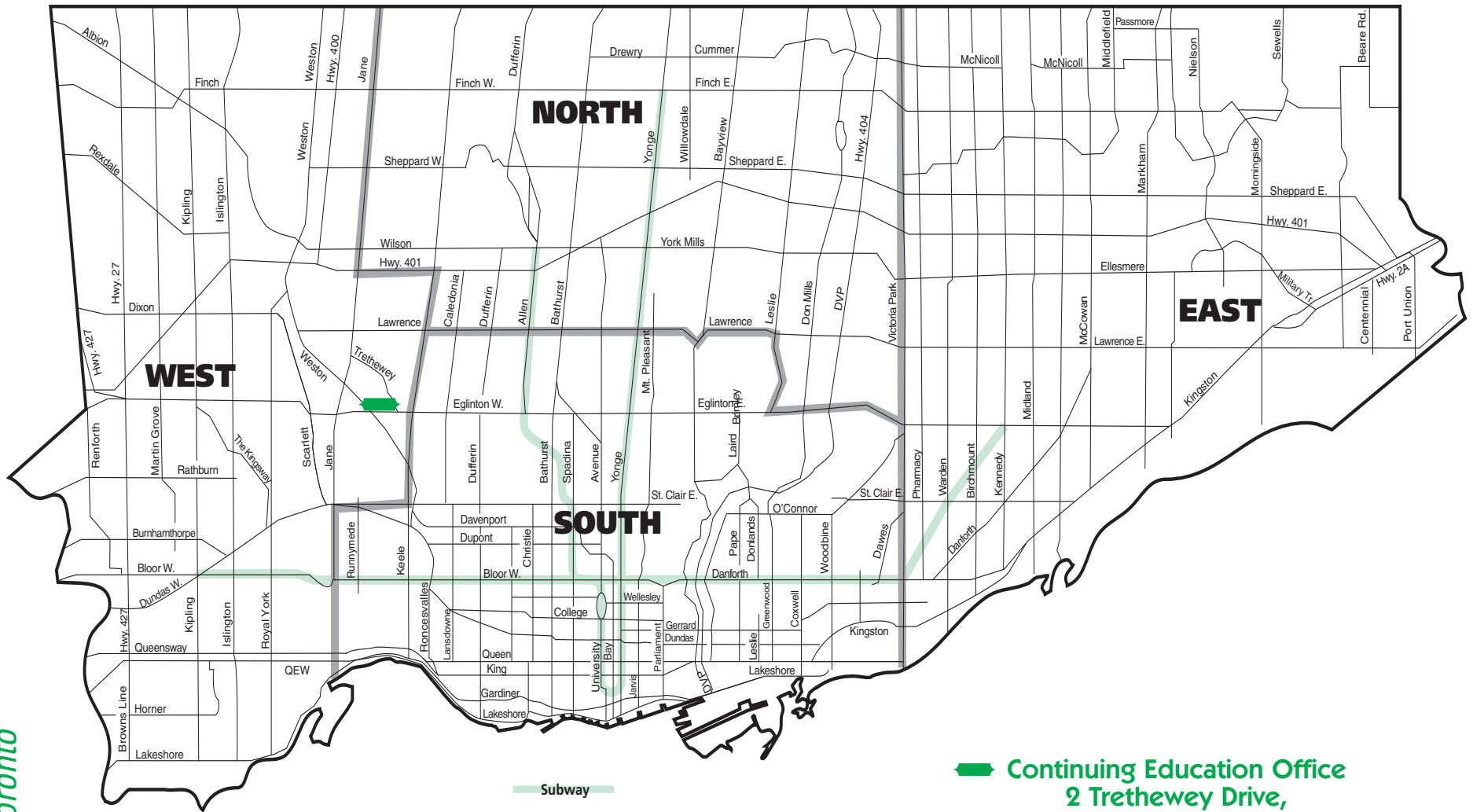

Program Information

English as a Second Language Programs

These are general programs in which students are taught English using the four language skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Classes are offered at the ESL literacy, beginner, intermediate, and advanced levels.

Bilingual ESL Programs

In these classes, the instructors speak English and the same first language as the students. Students who have difficulty understanding what is being taught in English can attend these classes to prepare themselves for the regular programs.

Citizenship Preparation Programs

These programs are for students who have been landed immigrants for at least 3 years and who are ready to take their Canadian Citizenship test. They will learn about citizenship requirements and Canada's history, geography and government system.

English for Business Skills/Computers

These programs focus on language skills for success in the workplace. A variety of programs are offered in business communication, ESL for accounting and computers and job search.

Specialty Classes

Some locations offer specialty classes like pronunciation, conversation and spelling.

English for Special Needs Programs

These programs are for learners with emotional and/or mental health needs.

English for Testing (TOEFL/CAEL/MELAB/IELTS) and for Academic Purposes

These programs are for intermediate or advanced level students who have professional or academic goals such as attending secondary schools, colleges or universities, or who are planning to requalify in their professions in Canada.

Προγράμματα Αγγλικών για Ενηλικούς ως Δευτερη Γλωσσα

Inglés como Segunda Lengua para Adultos

El Consejo Escolar del Distrito de Toronto ofrece una amplia gama de clases de inglés como segunda lengua para adultos considerados nuevos residentes canadienses. El programa ofrece enseñanza del idioma, orientación con respecto a la comunidad y los servicios disponibles además de preparación académica para mejorar el nivel educativo de los inmigrantes. Algunas de las clases que se ofrecen son: Conversación; Pronunciación; Preparación para el Examen de Ciudadanía Canadiense; Preparación para rendir exámenes académicos en inglés y alfabetización para quienes requieren mejorar sus conocimientos de lectura y escritura.

Programas de Inglês como Segunda Língua

A Direcção Escolar de Toronto oferece uma variedade de classes de inglês para adultos recentes no país. O programa oferece instrução naquela língua, orientação dentro da comunidade e aos serviços disponíveis, assim como preparação académica para mais educação. Algumas das classes oferecidas são: conversação; preparação para cidadania; preparação para testes de proficiência em língua; alfabetização, para aqueles que precisam aprender a ler e a escrever, e instrução bilíngue onde o inglês é ensinado com a ajuda da língua materna do aluno.

Chương trình Anh Văn dành cho Người Lớn như là Ngôn Ngữ Thứ Hai

Sở Giáo Dục Toronto hiện tổ chức một số lớp dạy Anh Văn dành cho người lớn (tuổi trưởng thành) mới đến Canada. Chương trình gồm có giảng dạy sinh ngữ, hướng dẫn về cộng đồng và các dịch vụ được cung cấp, cũng như chuẩn bị cho những người muốn theo học bậc cao hơn trong tương lai. Một số lớp hiện thời gồm có: đàm thoại; hướng dẫn nhập tịch, luyện thi sinh ngữ; dạy đọc và viết, dành cho những người cần nâng cao kỹ năng đọc và viết; và các chương trình song ngữ với tiếng Anh được giảng dạy bởi những người nói cùng tiếng mẹ đẻ với học viên.

Canadian Language Benchmarks

What are the Canadian Language Benchmarks?

The Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) are the national standard used in Canada for describing, measuring and recognizing the English language proficiency of adult immigrants and prospective immigrants for living and working in Canada.

The CLB provide a descriptive scale of communicative proficiency in English as a Second Language, expressed as benchmarks or reference points. They cover four skill areas: reading, writing, speaking and listening, and use real life language tasks to measure language skills.

The CLB provide a framework of reference for learning, teaching, programming and assessing adult English as a Second Language in Canada, a national standard for planning second language curricula for a variety of contexts, and a common "yardstick" for assessing the outcomes.

The benchmarks to describe English proficiency are from 1 – 12 and there are 4 stages of ESL for Literacy learners. The Toronto District School Board offers ESL classes at the following levels: ESL Literacy, CLB 1, CLB 2, CLB 3, CLB 4, CLB 5, CLB 6, CLB 7, CLB 8. In our brochure, we describe these classes as follows:

Registration Requirements

Program Eligibility

To register as a qualified resident of Canada and to participate in our programs, a learner must be:

- eighteen years old, or an early school leaver who has completed his/her high school diploma and is not a day school pupil enrolled in any publicly supported day school in Ontario and whose first language is neither English nor French and
- a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, Convention refugee or a refugee claimant; or
- a provincial nominee, or their dependent, who has been approved through the Opportunities Ontario: Provincial Nominee Program but has not yet been processed to receive permanent resident status; or
- a temporary foreign worker, or their dependent, who has been approved through the Canadian Experience Class
- a foreign domestic worker admitted under the Live-In Caregiver program.

The above learners must show proof of status before being registered and admitted to class. Only the following documents will be acceptable as proof of residency:

- Permanent Resident Card
- Acknowledgement of Intent to Claim (Refugee Status)
- Refugee Claimant Document
- Convention Refugee Status (white paper)
- Canadian Citizenship Card
- Canadian Passport
- Work permit AND a Letter indicating acceptance into the Opportunities Ontario: Provincial Nominee Program

- Confirmation letter from Citizenship and Immigration Canada confirming approval for Permanent Residency
- Live-In Caregiver Work Permit issued by Citizenship and Immigration Canada.

Non-Resident Students

Non-resident students (including visitors to Canada and persons in Canada on a student visa) are required to pay a course fee. This fee is \$7 per instructional hour (HST included) and must be paid, prior to registration, at one of the adult ESL administration centres. Course fees are payable by certified cheque, money order or cash to the Toronto District School Board. Students must register for a course for a minimum of 2 weeks. Course fees are non-refundable.
